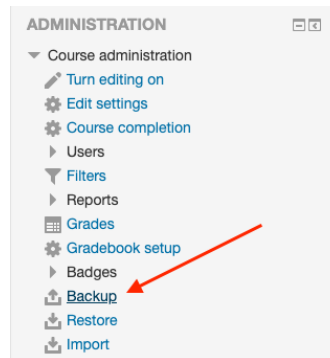


Using Backup and Restore to copy and move several activities from EduLINC to Avenue

Teachers may wish to re-use some activities from an EduLINC course which wasn't migrated to Avenue. This can be done using Backup and Restore. This file illustrates how to move several activities at once. For instructions on moving a single activity, see the file **Using Backup and Restore to Copy and Move an Activity from EduLINC to Avenue**.

Note: If you wish to copy an entire Topic from an EduLINC course, it will be much easier if you add an empty topic to your destination course on Avenue first, and place it in the correct position in that course (e.g., if you wish to copy the third Topic from your EduLINC course, put an empty topic in the third position of your Avenue course).

1. On the **EduLINC** course home page, click on the **Administration** menu and choose **Backup**.





The **Backup** page appears.

2. On the **Initial settings** page, use the settings as follows, and then scroll down and click on the **Next** button.

3. The **Schema Settings** page is displayed. Click None.

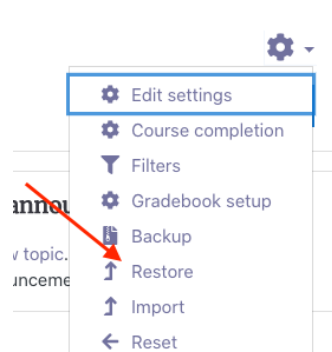
8. On the next page, locate the backup file of the activity you backed up in the **User Private Backup Area**. The time and date can help you. Click the **Download** button next to the file. Do not click **Restore**.

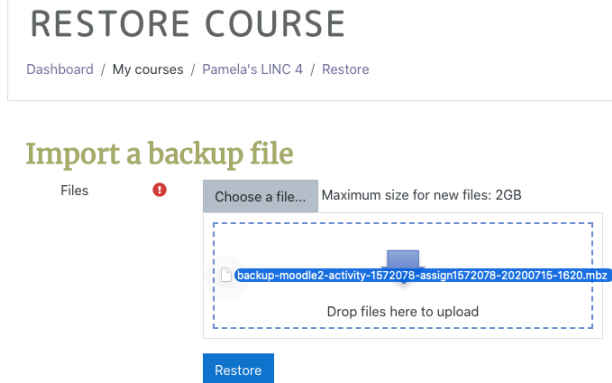

10. On the Restore Course page, drag and drop the backup file.

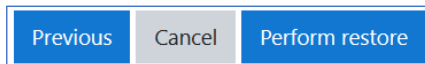

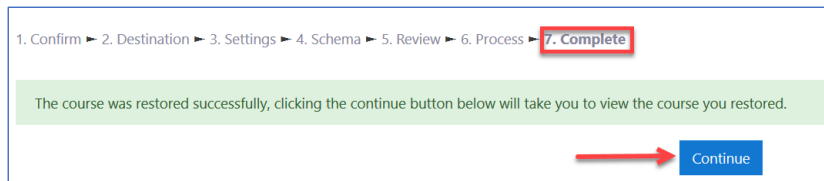

16. Click the **Next** button on the **Schema** settings page.

17. Click the **Perform restore** button at the bottom of the **Review** page.



18. Click the **Continue** button on the **Complete** page.



The target course home page appears. All chosen activities have been added to the course. They are each located at the bottom of the Topic they came from (**by number**). For example, if an activity came from the third topic in your source course, it will be at the bottom of the third topic in the destination course. Click **Turn Editing on** to move activities to their preferred locations in the course.

Depending on circumstances, you may find topic names or summaries have been changed (including for Topic 0). Verify these after you have Restored your material.
