

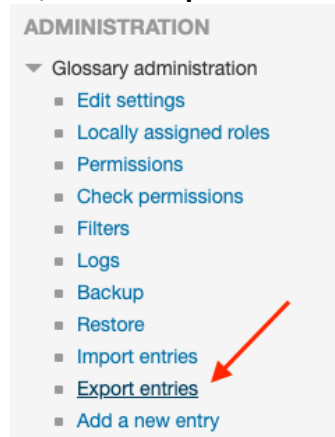
If you have built your own glossaries in EduLINC, you can export the entries in EduLINC and import them into your new Avenue course.

Exporting Items from a Teacher-built Glossary on EduLINC

1. In your EduLINC course, locate and click on a **glossary** link.



2. In the **Glossary Administration** menu, choose **Export Entries**.



3. Click the **Export Entries to File** button.

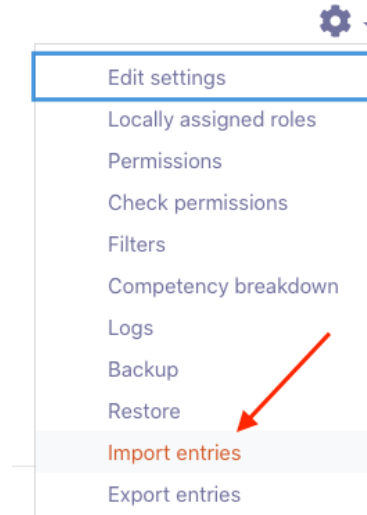


The file is downloaded on your computer.

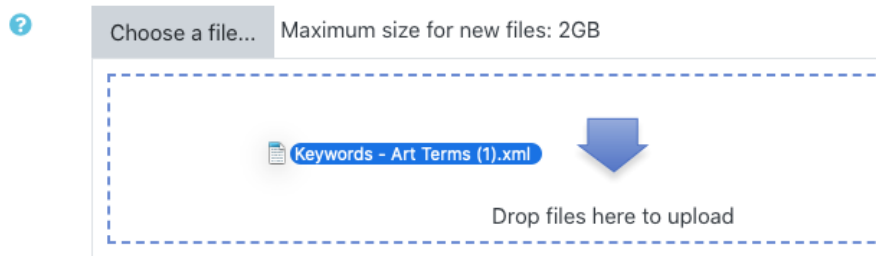
Importing Items to your Glossary on Avenue

1. In your Avenue course, locate and click on the same **glossary** link. The glossary contains no entries.

- In the **Glossary Action** menu, choose **Import Entries**.



- Drag and drop the downloaded XML file into the Drag and Drop box.



- On the **Import entries from XML file** page, click on the **Submit** button.
