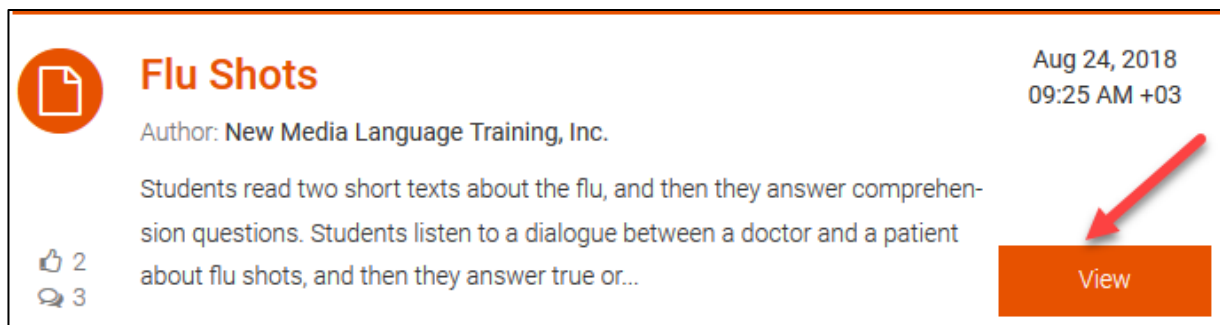
This document explains how to rate and comment on **SCORM** and **H5P** objects on Tutela.

Rating and Commenting on a SCORM Learning Object

To assist the community continually improve sharable SCORM learning objects on Tutela, there are two user-friendly features. The rating and comments features will assist other instructors to decide if a SCORM learning object is suitable for their courses.

After using Tutela's search function to find a **SCORM learning object**, preview it.


1. Click on the **View** button to display more information. This includes rating and commenting.



2. Under the title of the SCORM object, ratings in the form of **Likes** appears along with the number of comments.



3. To add your vote (like), click on the **thumbs up** icon to let your colleagues know that you endorse the quality and usefulness of this SCORM resource. (There is no thumbs down option)

Note: The **Likes** indicator adds your vote.  3 Likes

4. Beside the **Likes** icon is the **Comments** icon. Click on the **Comments** icon.
Note: The screen focus jumps to the **Comments** section.

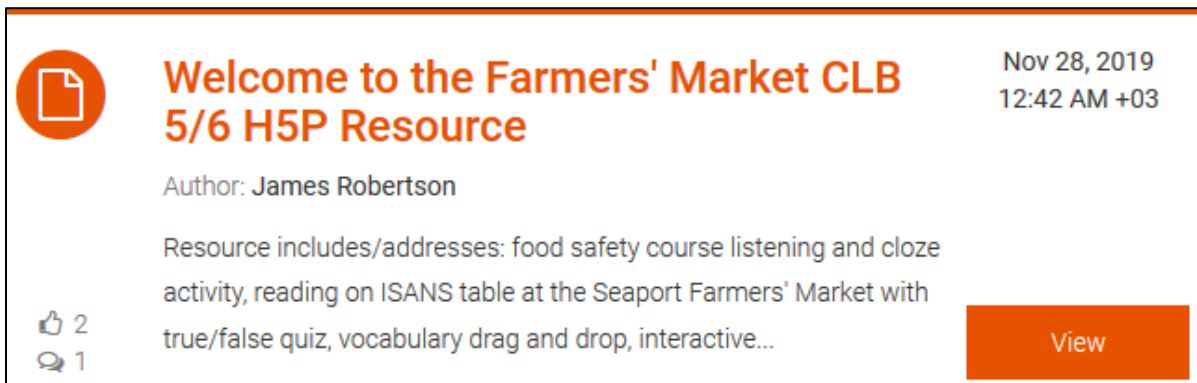

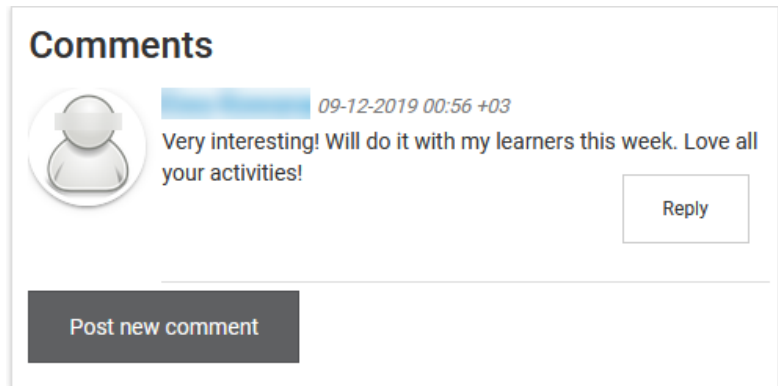

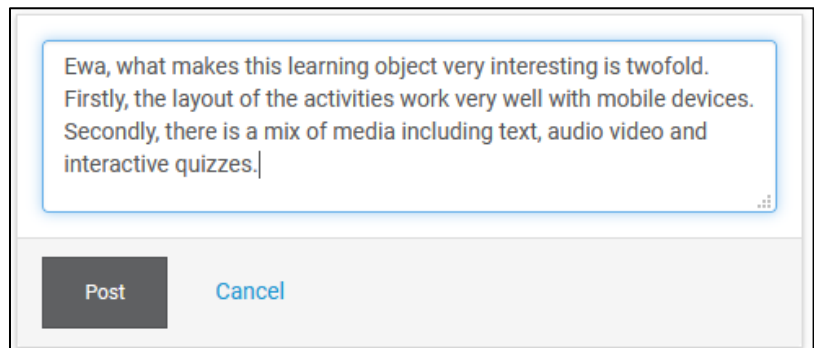
