# **Tutela Registration**

Tutela is an Opened and Closed repository and community. This means that it is closed to the outside world but open to all of its members that join. In order to participate and use Tutela, you need to create an account through the registration page.

The account is free to create, once you complete the process. The Tutela team will verify the information and approve the account. This approval process typically takes around 24h.

## Access the registration page

- 1. Use your web browser to go to http://tutela.ca/
- 2. Click the Sign Up button near the top right corner.
